### Student Discipline

---

- Teacher may suspend student for one class for the reasons listed on the attached page.
- The teacher is responsible for:
  - ✓ Contacting parents to release student from class
  - ✓ Contacting parents to explain reason for suspension
  - ✓ Notifying Administrator to see if additional discipline is necessary
- If teacher recommends a behavior contract, advisor will prepare contract and give copies to school counselor and teacher. Teacher notifies student and parent of contract status and forwards copies.
- If a student returns to class without contract, teacher will contact parent to release student from class until contract is returned. Teachers to notify advisor that contract not returned. Advisor to follow up with student/parent for signed contract before student returns to class.
