

CRITERIA FOR OUTSTANDING STUDENT SELECTION

Each teacher identifies one Outstanding Student in their classroom each semester.

All Hart District Outstanding Students will be recognized at their school site, will receive a gold seal on their certificate of completion, and will be invited to participate at the Hart ROP "Interview Night".

Examples of characteristics of the **Hart ROP Outstanding Student of the Class**:

- On time and has good attendance
- Completes assignments on time
- Participates in classroom discussions
- Helps other students
- Shows enthusiasm in the subject
- Communicates regularly with the teacher as a mentor
- Asks questions about working in the field
- Applies for scholarships
- Creates a portfolio
- Life impacted by ROP

Students must bring a project as an example of what they've learned in class to Interview Night

Teachers should hold the project for Fall students until Spring
